Parental Circular

Dear Parent

We at SPS are doing our bit to save the Planet Earth from the ill effects of global warming by taking various initiatives like saving water through rain water harvesting, saving electricity by using solar panels and discouraging the use of plastic bags/items.

In this connection CBSE has also issued Circular No. CBSE/DIR(ACAD)2019 wherein it has initiated

- (1) A massive tree plantation campaign, the CBSE ONE CHILD, ONE PLANT CAMPAIGN, under which each student must plant a sapling, know about its species and benefits.
- (2) 'Water Conservation' project in consonance with the Government of India initiative, wherein it is mandatory for each child to save one litre of water every day at home and in school. This can be done by:
 - taking shorter showers and using low flow shower head.
 - conserving energy as energy and water are linked.
 - reusing and recycling as it conserves water need to make plastic / paper / cloth.
 - closing taps, switching off electric appliances when not in use.

It is the duty of each one of us to contribute towards saving the environment and sensitizing our children to do so. So as a part of social initiative ask the children to –

- Save water
- Save electricity
- Grow a plant
- Stop using plastic bags and bottles
- Maintain cleanliness at home, on roads and at public places.
